- **Expect to file in 1st quarter 2007**
 - (need 1 year publication)
- **Expect favorable decision in 6-12 months**
 - ALL articles from Vol 1, Inaugural will be indexed when *IM* accepts SiH
- **Indexed in OVID right away**

 - Both empirical data and theory are important
 - Forum for disseminating work and ideas on simulation and health policy
